The fifth event in the CASC-OR 2005 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News' On The Grid magazine was held at the Bronte GO Station in Oakville on July 17th. The Event, organized by Blair Duguid of the Competition Corvette Club (COMP), had 70 of Ontario's best Solo 2 competitors.



While on the short trip from Toronto to Oakville, for the first regional event of the season in the Greater Toronto Area, it started to lightly sprinkle. The previous day had broken a very long dry spell with heavy rains and it was looking like this day would be similar. During the morning preparations it did indeed start to rain and it continued off and on for most of the day, along with the continued high temperatures and extremely high humidity.


The first runs were run in wet conditions with light rain. The second runs were in drying conditions, with the latter

competitors in the run group getting the advantage of the continuing drying conditions. During the third runs the approaching thunder storms descended on the Bronte GO Station lot, halting the event for 45 minutes due to the unsafe conditions for the marshals (whom were stationed under massive metal light standards in the middle

Only two tenths of a second separated the top five fastest times of the day.

The top scorer of the day was once again Hanif P in his H-Stock Honda Civic followed by two time Overall Series Champion Marshall M and Pete M, both also in H-Stock Civics. The Top Novice was
