

CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News, **Event # 1 Director's Report**



For quite a few years now a CASC-OR sanctioned club from Eastern Ontario, St. Lawrence Auto Club (St. Lac.), have been hosting Autoslalom events and with all that experience St. Lac. knows how to put on a great event. The CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsports News season kicked off with the 8th annual Judy Brunner Memorial Slalom which took place on Sunday May 28th at Picton Airfield just outside of Picton, Ontario. Judy Brunner, a former CASC Regional and National Solo Champion, made sure the weather cooperated; in fact the day was awesome. Once again for 2006 the event organizer was Judy's son, Rob Brunner, and with the help of the Kingston based club they again put on a top notch event for the 63 competitors that made the trip.

Fortunately most of the drivers participating on this day would have graduated from the television show long before the other "worst drivers"....

As was the case in 2005, the Series Timing Committee is looking after all aspects of data entry and timing of each event, leaving each clubs organizers to concentrate on

hosting a great event. St. Lac.'s laid back atmosphere was conducive to a great event and was enhanced by them not having to look after timing. Further additions to the series timing system for the 2006 season will enhance the Solo experience and create some needed redundancy. We've come a long way from the days of using stop watches.....















The course layout made the first two thirds of the course fast and wide open then tightening up a bit through the last third without losing the "flow" of the course. Most of the run times were in the low to mid 60 second range with only nine competitors managing to break the 60 second barrier. Kyle L in his very quick A Street Prepared Subaru Sti set the Fastest Time of the Day at 58.054. Second quickest was the E Super Stock Subaru Impreza WRX of Rhys H back at 58.819 seconds and following in third at 58.896 was Paul K and his supercharged C Street Prepared Mazda Miata.

All 63 competitors managed to get in 5 timed runs, have an awards presentation, then approximately 45 minutes of \$1 fun runs, with the proceeds going to the Lung Association. A lot of the competitors present were making their way home before 4pm, which is unusual these days. For the 2006 season, events are limited to a minimum of three and a maximum of six timed runs for scoring. This allows competitors to know in advance how many runs to expect as some events in previous years were three or four runs and other events were eight



or nine runs depending and course layout, number of competitors, organization, etc. This sometimes allows for more "fun runs" at the end of the day so competitors can experiment with handling settings that they may not otherwise be willing to try during competition runs.

There were a couple of good class battles throughout the day. D Street Prepared had brothers Mike and Steve H both duking it out in their 87 Volkswagen Scirocco 16V with Mike nudging Steve by a half second. Tashko S and his TDS Engineering / Cooksville Mitsubishi / Amsoil E Street Prepared Mitsubishi Eclipse GSX beat out Paul M's Subaru WRX by 3/10s of a second in another close class. B Stock was yet another close battle with St. Lac's Marc G in a Nissan 300 ZX TT narrowly displacing

another St. Lac member, Paul M in his Porche 911 RS, by less than 2/10s of a second. Down in G Stock, Bill R in a new Honda Civic Si took the class win over Trung D in his Subaru Impreza. Trung was frustrated with the defeat, but Bill has been around the block a few times and is always fast......

The closest battle of the day was in A Super Stock where Burl V in his Porsche 911 SC battled it out with Mike M and his Subaru WRX STi, with Burl coming out on top by 1/10 of a second at the end of the day. If Burl was using fresh and matched tires I am sure the gap would have opened up substantially.

















For the second season now a PAX index (a performance index used to level the field) will be used to determine the Overall Championship. The above mentioned G Stock competitor Bill R in a 2006 Civic Si took the early Overall Championship lead with a score of 100 on the event, followed by last year's Series Overall Champion

Hanif P in a D Stock Acura Integra Type R with a score of 99.817 and then Pete M's H Stock's Northern Performance Mini Cooper with a score of 99.693 in third.

During each season the series also has a Novice Championship and for 2006 it seems like the battle will be between Gary W in a B Stock Mazda RX-8, SPDA's Douglas M in a D Stock Subaru Legacy 2.5GT and OMSC's Jonas L in his D Street Prepared Volkswagon Scirocco. For the first event, Gary W came out on top of the Novices narrowly beating out Douglas for the Top Novice honour.





As mentioned above, St.Lac opened the CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News season off right with a fantastic event. A big thanks goes out to Rob, Eric, John and all the St. Lac. people for a great day.
