



CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series

 Event # 9 Director's Report



The morning of September 10th had the CASC-OR 2006 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News all the way out in Kanata, just west of Ottawa, for Event # 9 in the ten event series. The penultimate event in the 2006 Autoslalom series was held at the recently re-branded Scotiabank Place and hosted by the Motorsport Club of Ottawa (MCO). Event organizer Chuck Payne and the MCO crew had a quick 64 plus second and very interesting course, one that had been used in the reverse direction the day before for their Ontario/Quebec Inter-Provincial Cup Challenge event.

In addition to the usual series core competitors, MCO's hosted event on the Ontario Regional schedule had a fairly good turnout from the MCO regulars and a few competitors that had made the trip from Montreal to see how they would fair against some of Ontario's finest Autoslalom competitors. The event attracted 67 competitors from Ontario and Quebec, down from the reported numbers at the Inter-Provincial Cup Challenge event the day before.

The weather was fine for an early September morning with temperatures in the mid teens and a mix of sun and cloud. It was a little too cool for short sleeves and too warm for a jacket and one of those days that some unsuspecting competitors managed to get sunburns, not noticing the amount of sun they were receiving and feeling no need for the protection offered by sun screen.

This event didn't really have many close class battles. The only real battle was in D Stock where Montreal's Carl W. in his TRAC Racing Acura Integra Type R took the class win with a time of 63.885 seconds over the class leader and reigning Series Overall Champion Hanif P. in his Type R who posted his quickest time of 63.897 seconds. Carl took the class win by a mere 12/1000ths of a second. Third in D Stock was Carl's co-driver, Bruno L. with a time of 64.025 seconds putting the top three just over 1/10th of a second apart. Two and a half seconds back of the top three had another close battle with Jason K. in a Subaru WRX, Brian S. in his MOSI Race Dynamics / eterness.com / Dave Wood Mazda MazdaSpeed Protege and Bryan C. in a Subaru Legacy GT all within 6/10ths of each other.



F Super Stock was the only other close class battle with the Series Chief Timer Jason D. in his SIERRA Equipment / www.intralink360.com / Pathfinder Lubricants / CG-Lock Honda Civic with a time of 66.987 followed by Andrew R. in his Subaru Legacy with a time of 67.417 seconds. Most of the other classes were won by margins of more than a second and most of the series regulars finished at the top of their respective classes.

Where the battle really heated up was when the PAX (a performance index system used to level the playing field for all competitors) was applied to the fastest times to calculate the Overall Series Results. The top four scorers for Overall all scored above 99.7 points, a very slim margin indeed. Nine of the top ten Overall were series regulars and regulars at the top of the Overall Results.

The Event 9 "Northern Motorsport Top Scorer Award", for the second time this season, was Montreal's Carl W., scoring the 100 points followed by Hanif P. with a score of 99.981, both from D Stock. Bill R. in a G Stock 2006 Honda Civic Si with a score of 99.850 finished third. Another competitor that made the trip from Montreal, Bruno L., co-driving Carls' Type R, was fourth with a score of 99.781 followed by H Stock's Pete M in his Northern Motorsport Honda Civic with a score of 98.809.





The second place Overall finish at Event # 9 for Hanif P. allowed him to secure his second Overall Series Championship. Pete M. who is second overall just managed to stay ahead of Bill R who jumped up to third Overall, displacing CASC-OR Solo 2 Director, Wes T., down to fourth and Daniel F. to fifth Overall.



There was only one novice for Event # 9 so the Top Novice went to Douglas M. in his D Stock Subaru Legacy 2.5GT.

The Fastest Time of the Day went to Mike A., aka Jesus, in his D Street Prepared Subaru Impreza 2.5 RS with a time of 62.091 seconds followed by MCO club member Fritz M. in his B Street Prepared Nissan 350Z with a time of 62.395. The newly acquired D Street Prepared Dodge

Neon fielded by Trung D. with a time of 63.297 was third. Geoff C. and his E Street Prepared Subaru WRX was only 15/1000ths of a second behind Trung with a time of 63.274 in fourth and fifth was D Modified's Klaus W. and his BMW E30 with a time of 63.693 seconds.
