

The second day in the Double Header Provincial Autoslalom weekend at Bronte GO Station in Oakville had Eric Juraschka and COMP (Competition Corvette Club) organizing Event #3 of the six event **CASC-OR 2007 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Racing News** schedule. Event # 3 took place on Sunday, June 17th.

The weather forecast was calling for sun and 30 degree temperatures with a very good chance of thunder storms in the late afternoon. The forecast was at least partially correct as it was sunny and very hot for a mid-June Sunday afternoon, but the thunder storms did hold off.

COMP had much better luck with the parking lot as most of the cars that had been still in the parking lot the previous morning were almost all gone leaving Eric and his crew to utilize a little more of the large asphalt parking lot for their course. They managed a course that had some competitors grabbing third gear for a short stint before going back into a slower section. The course was also quite a bit longer than the previous day, this time the fastest competitors were in the low 53 seconds range and the bulk of the field in the upper 50s somewhere.

Given that the course was a lot more open and flowing than the day before, there wasn't a lot of really close battles for the class wins, but there definitely were a few..... The closest battle was in D Street Prepared. On the Saturday, DSP competitor Daniel F. had some substantial issues with his Subaru Impreza 2.5 RS. Something in the drive train broke, leaving him to have his car towed home. The next morning fellow SPDA member Mike A. was good enough (Mike is a really nice guy) to offer up his similar prepped Impreza 2.5 RS to Daniel, his closest competitor, and the battle was on. Mike just managed to beat Daniel for the class win by 69/1000s of a second and right on their tails was Trung D. in his Plymouth Neon a mere 37/100s behind class winner Mike.

Other close class battles included, once again, the E upper Stock Subaru WRXs of Rhys H. and Peter W. with Rhys once again coming out on top, this time by three tenths of a second. G Stock had the CASC-OR Autoslalom Director, Pete M., and his Northern Motorsport '02 Mini Cooper S turning the tables from the previous day on Series Timer Cliff S. and edging Cliff out by two tenths of a second. G Stock should definitely be a class to watch over the remaining three events as these two are keeping each other on their toes and working for the wins.....

The Northern Motorsport Top Scorer Award for Event #3 wasn't a close battle at all. For the third event in a row the Top Scorer was the 2003 Overall Champion Marshall M. and his E Stock Miata. Marshall drove the wheels off his poor '90 Miata, so to speak, and has put himself in a very good position for the Overall Championship. With only three events left, there are only three other people with a shot at knocking Marshall off the top spot....





Paul K. and his C Street Prepared '92 Mazda Miata was second in the Overall Standings for the day, with a score of 98.376 followed very closely by the top three D Street Prepared competitors of Mike A. with 98.221, Daniel F. with 98.095 and fifth was Trung D. with a score of 97.563. And making things really interesting, the next four competitors in the Overall Championship all scored above 98.2.....

The Top Novice once again is Loui P. and his E Super Stock '05 Subaru Legacy GT beating out the D Super Stock '05 Subaru Impreza 2.5RS of Nathan H. Loui is well on his way to wrapping up the Novice Championship, but with three events left on the schedule, who knows what will happen.
