



CASC-OR 2007 Mobil 1 Autoslalom Championship Series
 Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News,
 Event # 4 Report



July 22nd was a beautiful Sunday here in Ontario and the **CASC-OR 2007 Mobil1 Championship Series Sponsored by Inside Track Motorsport News** had competitors making the trek to Sarnia for Round 4 of Provincial Autoslalom Series hosted by Western Ontario Sports Car Association (WOSCA) and presented by Fenwick Subaru. The Hiawatha Horse Park lot is an excellent lot and WOSCA's organizer, Jeremy Schmidt, made good use of the lot with possibly one of the best, if not the best courses in recent years.



For the first time this season, run groups were used to divide up competitors. The concept worked very well and everyone who was willing, managed eight runs. Times continued to drop all day as the course got sticker and although most of the experienced competitors set their fastest runs on the fifth or sixth runs, a lot of competitors continued to improve until their last run.

There were a few class battles that were tight, some very tight indeed. F Super Stock was the closest with SCCA member Boucand V. in a '66 Porsche 912 crossing the

border from Michigan and edging out the '87 CRX of CASC-OR interim Secretary and OMSC member, Bruce G., by a mere 9/1000s of a second for the class win.

In C Super Stock, Balaza S and his 1990 BMW 325is was very quick and narrowly beat WOSCA member Ben M. in his shared bright yellow '92 Miata. C Modified had another Michigan driver, Norm A., in a 1964 Austin Cooper, edging out the shared 1990 Civic driven by Jeremy O. and David P. who finished second and third respectively, each separated by three tenths of a second.

D Super Stock was close as well. Series regular, Shane G. had some misfortune with his ride on site. He sheared the axle nut right off his driver's side drive shaft preparing for competition. Series Director, Pete M. was good enough to offer Shane a co-drive and Shane just missed out on the class win by three tenths of a second. Darcy W. in his Bluewater Optometric Clinic 2000 Civic SiR took the DSS win away from Shane.





E Street Prepared had a close battle between two Mustangs with WOSCA regulars Ted J. in his '86 Mustang GT and Ken F. in his '83 Mustang swapping the lead back and forth all day with Ted finally coming out on top by three tenths of a second. F Street Prepared had brothers Mike and Steve H. both battling in their shared '87 Volkswagen Scirocco 16V. Steve once again came out on top, just clipping his brother for the class win by a lowly two tenths of a second. These two are having a great battle for the Class Championship, with Mike just out in front by a hair. Stay tuned as these guys should add some extra spice to the very competitive series.

Now the battle once again was really tight at the top for the Overall Championship. The 2002/3 Overall Champion, Marshall M., had taken all of the first three Overall Championship wins, really narrowing down the list of potential candidates for the Overall Championship. He was not to be the winner Overall on this day, but was definitely in the mix. The top five Overall were all above 99 points and from five different classes with the top seven all above 98 points.

Fifth Overall was SPDA member and series regular Rhys H. in his E Super Stock Subaru WRX with a score of 99.137. Fourth went to another SPDA member, Cholo R and his B Super Stock Subaru STi, with an impressive score of 99.381. Second and third are names usually at the top of the heap. WOSCA's Marshall M. in his E Stock Miata was third with a score of 99.520 and second went Series Director, Pete M., in his G Stock Northern Motorsports Mini Cooper S with an "I'm right on you tail" score of 99.815.

The Northern Motorsports top Scorer Award for Event #4 went to the former CASC-OR Autoslalom Director and BARC/HADA member, Wes T. in his Tsunami Technology / Reaction Grafix / CG Lock Canada / GTA Wheel & Tire Zone / Pathfinder Lubricants H Stock Honda Civic SiR, who was on the ball right from the first few runs and was definitely the person to catch all day. Wes seemed to be able to step it up another notch, as needed, all day.

The Top Novice for Event #4 went to SPDA's Nathan H. in his D Super Stock Subaru Impreza 2.5 RS, just edging out Jeremy O. and his borrowed C Modified Honda Civic. The Fastest Time of the Day went to the fourth place Overall car of Cholo R. with a time of 42.382. Second fastest time was set by fellow SPDA member Mike A. and his Impreza putting down a time of 42.644 and third was the above mentioned Rhys H. with a time of 42.945 seconds.





The Series now takes a lengthy hiatus as the final two events in the six event series are at Picton Airport on September 15 & 16th. These events will be hosted by SPDA and St.Lac, respectively. There are lots of Class battles still up for grabs, although the list of potential candidates to knock Marshall off the top spot Overall is almost none existent at this point.
