1. Ice Race Regulations:

Change:

5.2.3 TEMPORARY LICENCE – NEW COMPETITOR
The cost of this temporary weekend licence will be **\$25** for the **2025** season.

Remove:

5.2.4 Temporary Licence – Returning Competitor

Add: Appendix D: Specialty Classes

LEXUS SPORT:

CASC-OR reserves the right to cancel the classes (LS and LS11) if it is determined that the ice wear is excessive.

The following exceptions to the Ice Race Regulations are allowed:

Vehicles: 2001-2004 Lexus IS 300. Eligible to run as LS or LS11 only.

Tires: must adhere to the current Street Stud Tire regulation (2.5.2 Street Studs) or:

- i) The Hankook Winter I Pike RS 215/45R17 91T
- ii) No more than 19 studs shall be placed in 1 foot of tire circumference. The body of the stud shall not protrude more than 2 millimetres from the tread block.
- iii) The studs shall be stud number TSMI 9-13 Cold Headed Steel Stud or Wiper-tec WT12 stud.
- iv) Gluing of studs is allowed, limited by the stipulation that the glue added does not alter the stud pocket depth.
- v) If the stud count exceeds 19, a second 1 foot section will be marked off and the studs will be counted and if the count exceeds 19 a third section may be checked. If the last count exceeds 19 the penalty will be applied.

STREET CUP:

This will be a non-contact run group. We recognize that we're racing on ice, but contact will be penalized at the discretion of the Series Director or the Clerk.

Air bags to be disabled by removing the fuse or the module.

If the car is licensed for road use, both the front and rear license plates must be removed.

The following are the allowed exceptions to the Ice Race Regulations:

- a) A fully prepped ice racer may not run with this group and these cars cannot run with our other groups.
- b) Lights must remain installed and be working. All cars will run with their lights on at all times. The "extra" rear facing running light is not required.
- c) All exterior lights must be covered by transparent tape or vinyl (i.e. we have to be able to see your lights at all times when you are on track).
- d) Car interiors shall remain in place, cars may not be lightened or modified from original stock.

- e) Tow hooks are recommended front and rear. If hooks are not installed, we will use a large hook and look to attached to some component on the underside of the car (likely suspension) to pull you out of a bank.
- f) Original equipment seat belts shall be in good working condition and used while the vehicle is on the race track.
- g) Numbers will be displayed on both sides of the car's windows, as well as in the upper right-hand corner of the front and rear windshields. It is preferred that the numbers be placed on the inside of the windows.
